Pledge/Donation Form A Century for Sight Yellowstone Trail Tour



The Manawa Lions are sponsoring a 100 year-old Oakland car travelling the “over 100 year-old” Wisconsin portion of the Yellowstone Trail while celebrating the 100th Anniversary of Lions Clubs International’s service to humanity. Donations and pledges will be collected for our Wisconsin Lions Camp at Rosholt, Wisconsin. This Lions Camp provides summer camping experiences for children and adults who are blind or visually impaired, deaf or hard of hearing, and intellectually disabled or have autism. Two weeks of camp are also held for children with diabetes.

Here’s how it works:

The drive will take place October 9-14, 2017. The route will begin in Hudson and end in Kenosha. Simply make a one-time donation or pledge an amount per each mile driven with the 1917 Oakland car without a major breakdown over the 406 mile trip. After the drive is completed, you will be notified of your pledge amount due. This can be an individual pledge/donation or a club pledge/donation.

Examples: If 406 miles were driven, your total pledge would be:

10 cents per mile = \$40.60

25 cents per mile = \$101.50

50 cents per mile = \$203.00

\$1.00 per mile = \$406.00
