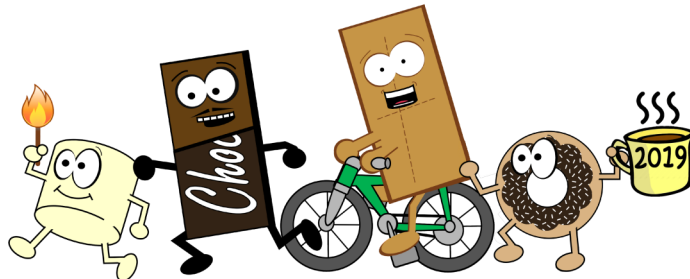

## Hustle S'more for Lions Camp 2019
